Attestation of Independent Security Assessment

OmegaWulf, Inc. was engaged by Pavex Commerce, Inc. ("the Client") to perform an independent penetration test of the Client's web application, public API, and Amazon Web Services production estate. Testing was performed from 12 May through 02 June 2026 under engagement letter MSA-2026-Q2-07-amend-1.

The engagement followed OmegaWulf's four-phase methodology — reconnaissance, exploitation, post-exploitation, and reporting — performed manually by named operators and supplemented by OmegaWulf SCOUT, our continuous-reconnaissance agent for AWS. Social-engineering, physical access, third-party SaaS, and destructive proofs of exploit were out of scope.

All findings identified during the engagement were communicated to the Client's designated engineering and security leadership and are documented in the accompanying technical report and executive summary. OmegaWulf has not disclosed, and will not disclose, the contents of those reports to any third party absent the Client's written authorisation.
